Unit Number: 1

Title: Military Leaders – Genghis Khan

Length of Unit: 6 weeks

Summary of Unit

This prescribed Paper 1 subject focuses on the well-known medieval military leader, the Mongol leader Genghis Khan and his impact. The first case study focuses on Genghis Khan and the expansion of the Mongol Empire in the early 13th century. Students will focus their learning on his rise to power, his military campaigns and reasons for his success. It will also analyse the importance of his leadership and the impact of expansion on the Mongol Empire and the wider world.

How will progress be measured?

Diagnostic Assessment:	Students will complete a knowledge harvest of the topics previously studied through completion of a Socrative online quiz.
Formative Assessment:	Over the course the unit students will use a range of activities to study a range of areas within this unit of study. They will partake in discussions, give presentations and analyse knowledge and evidence based around key questions. Feedback will be given both by peers and the teacher either verbally or in written comments.
Summative Assessment:	The unit will end with a formally assessed exam question compiled from previous examinations. This will be levelled using the IB History Paper 1 marks scheme relevant to the question answered. The level requirements will be shared with the students before the assessment and time will be given for students to prepare. Written feedback will be provided to all students.
