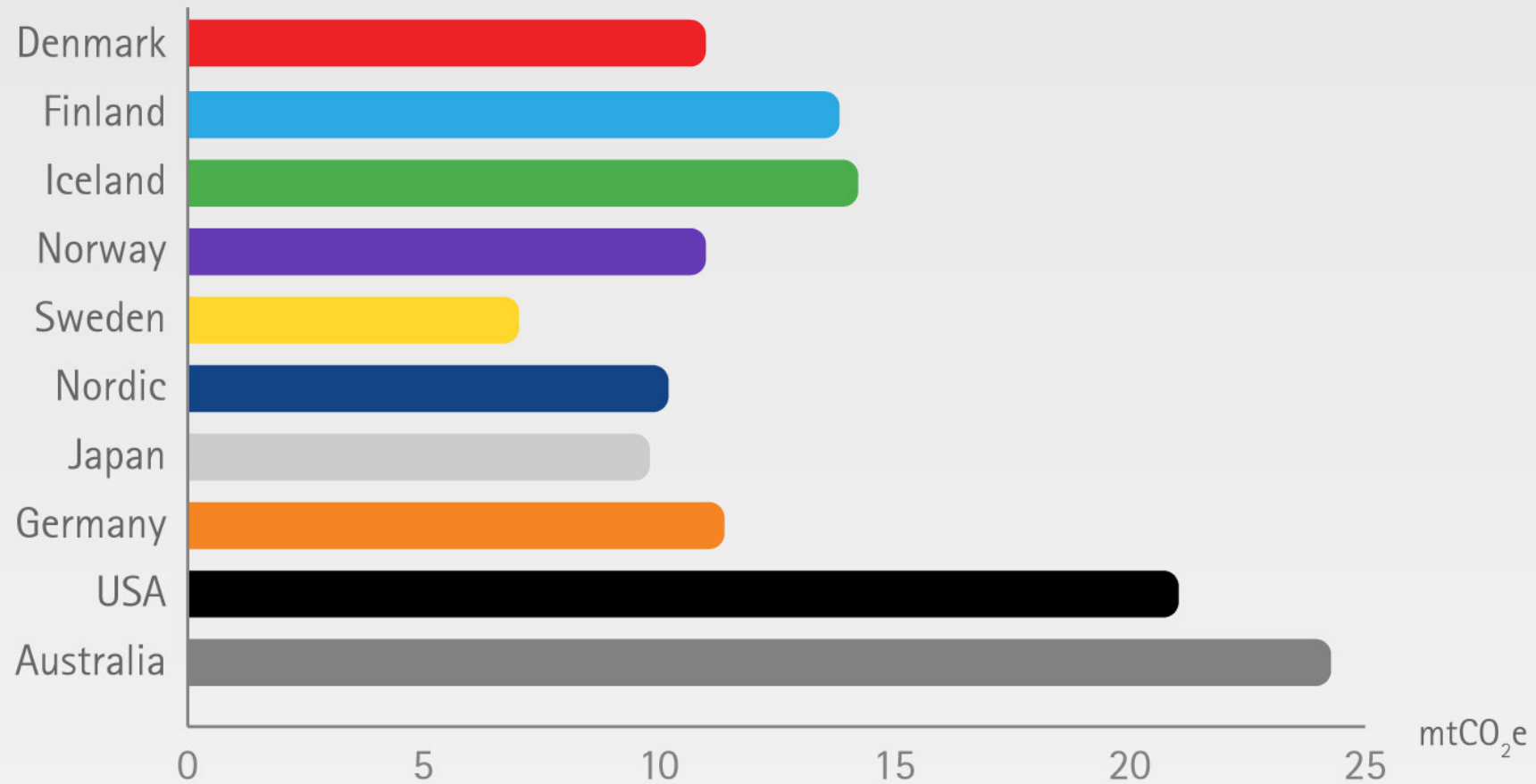
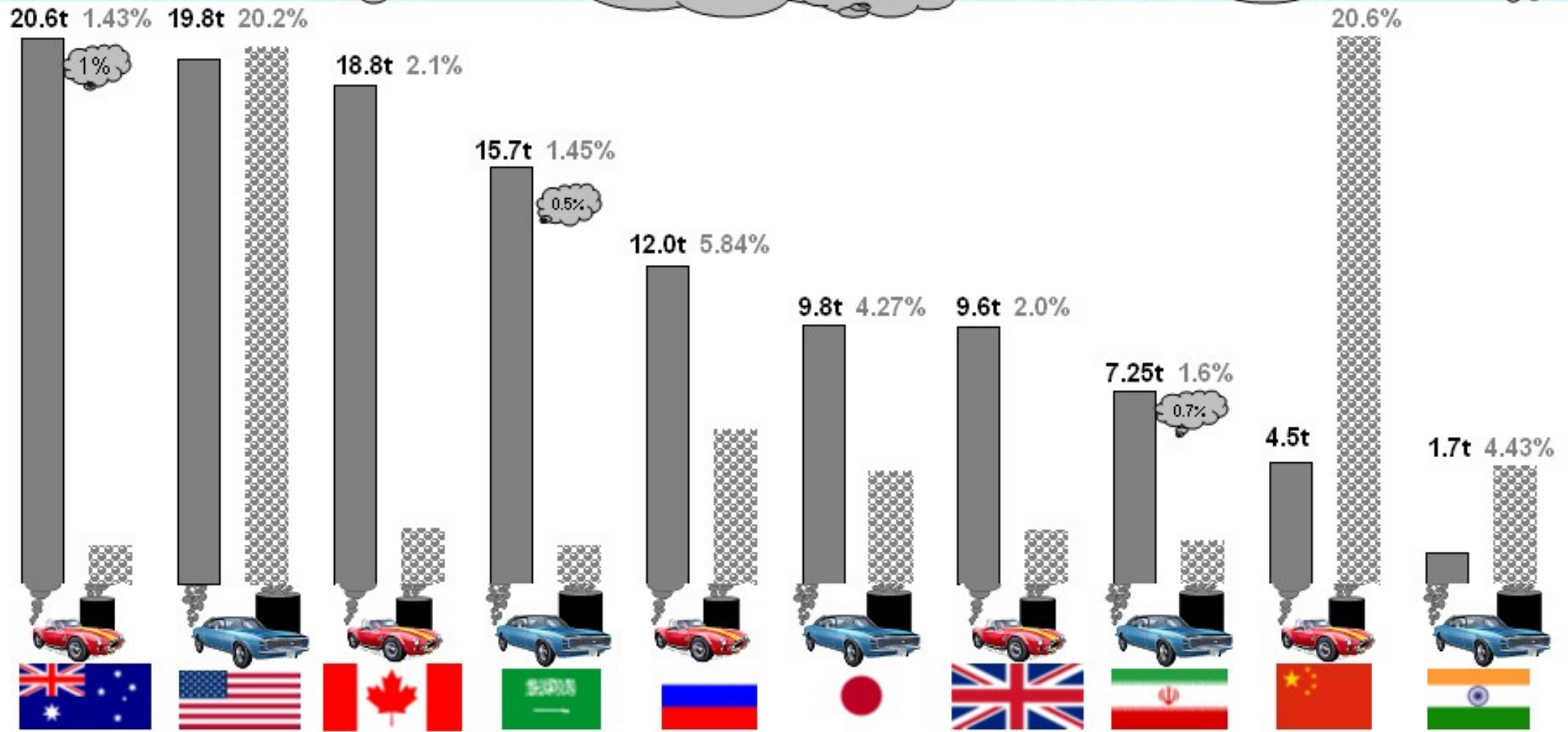

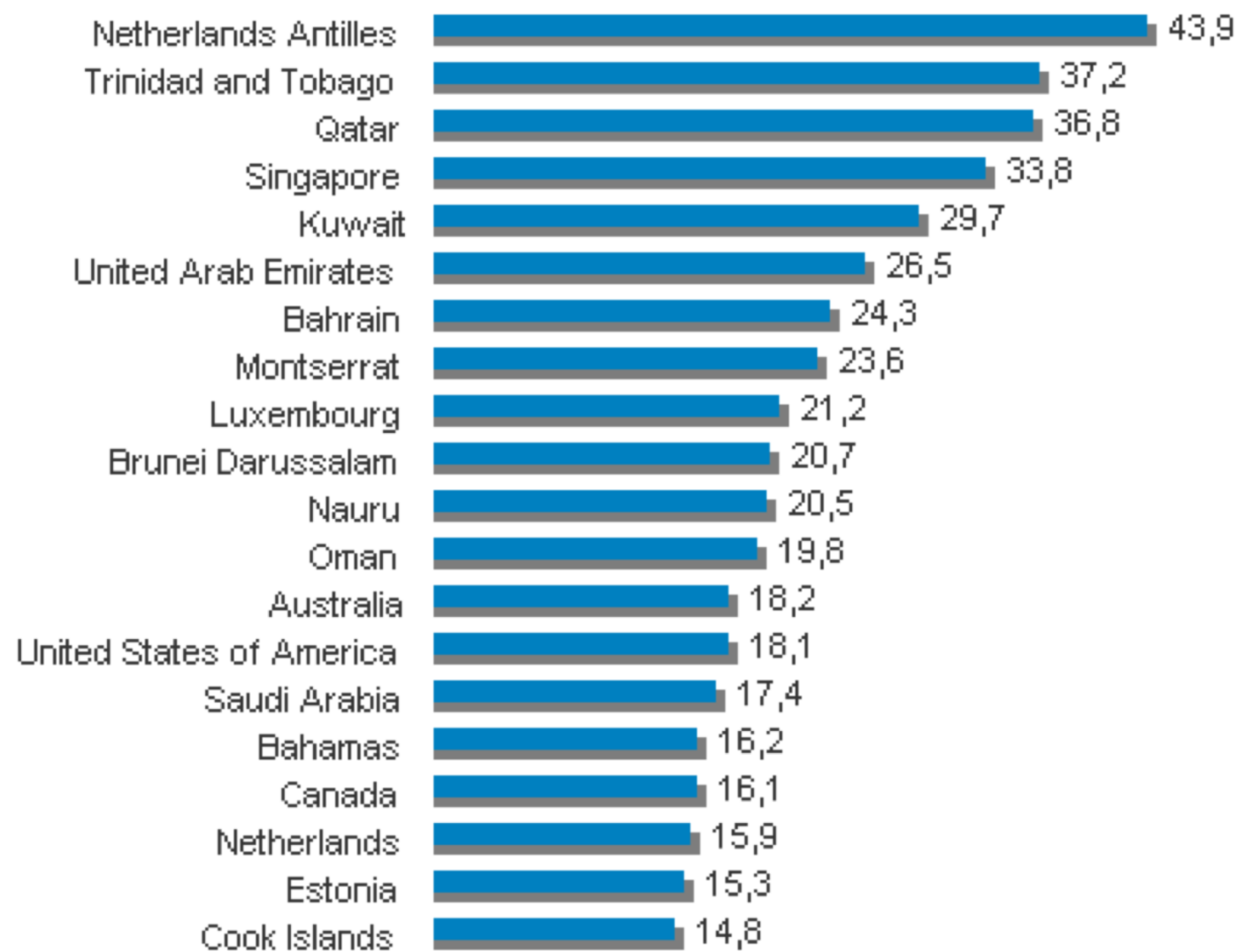
Greenhouse gas emissions per capita 2010



Per capita co2 Pollution in 2006: 2006: Total co2 pollution as % of world: Total co2 pollution emitted 1850-2004 as % of world:



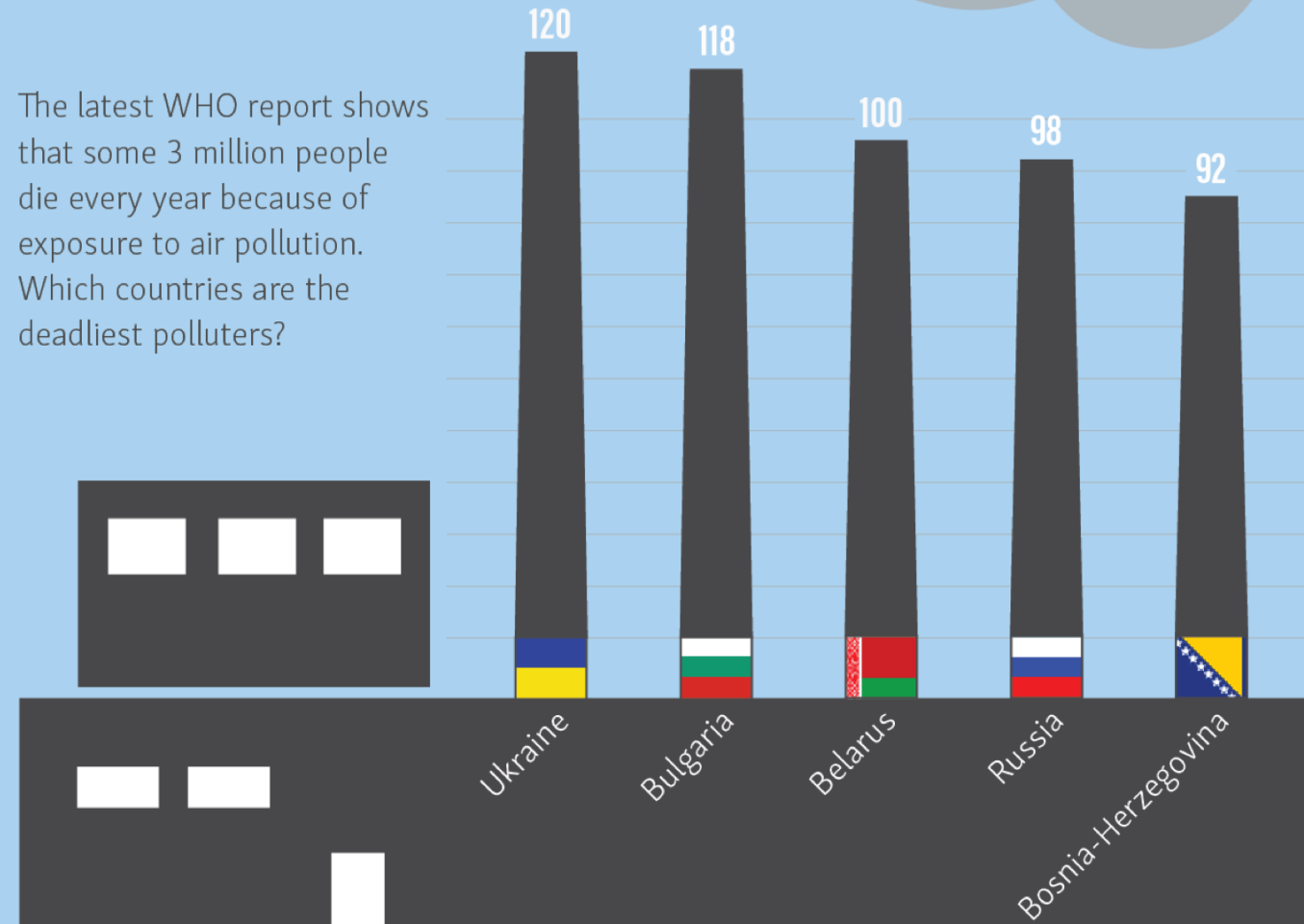
World TOP 20 Countries with highest CO2 emissions per capita from Energy Consumption in 2010 (MtCO2 per million people)

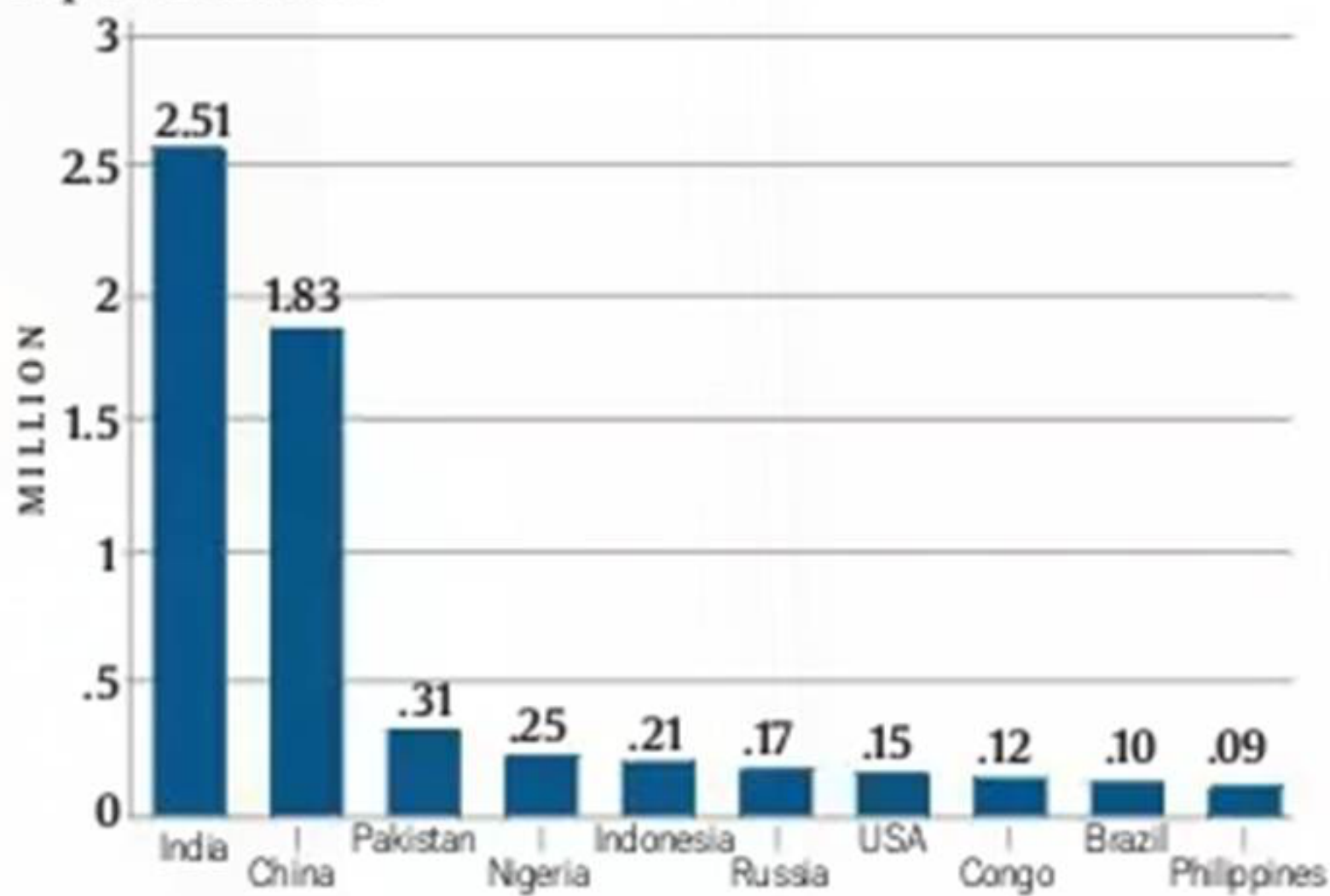

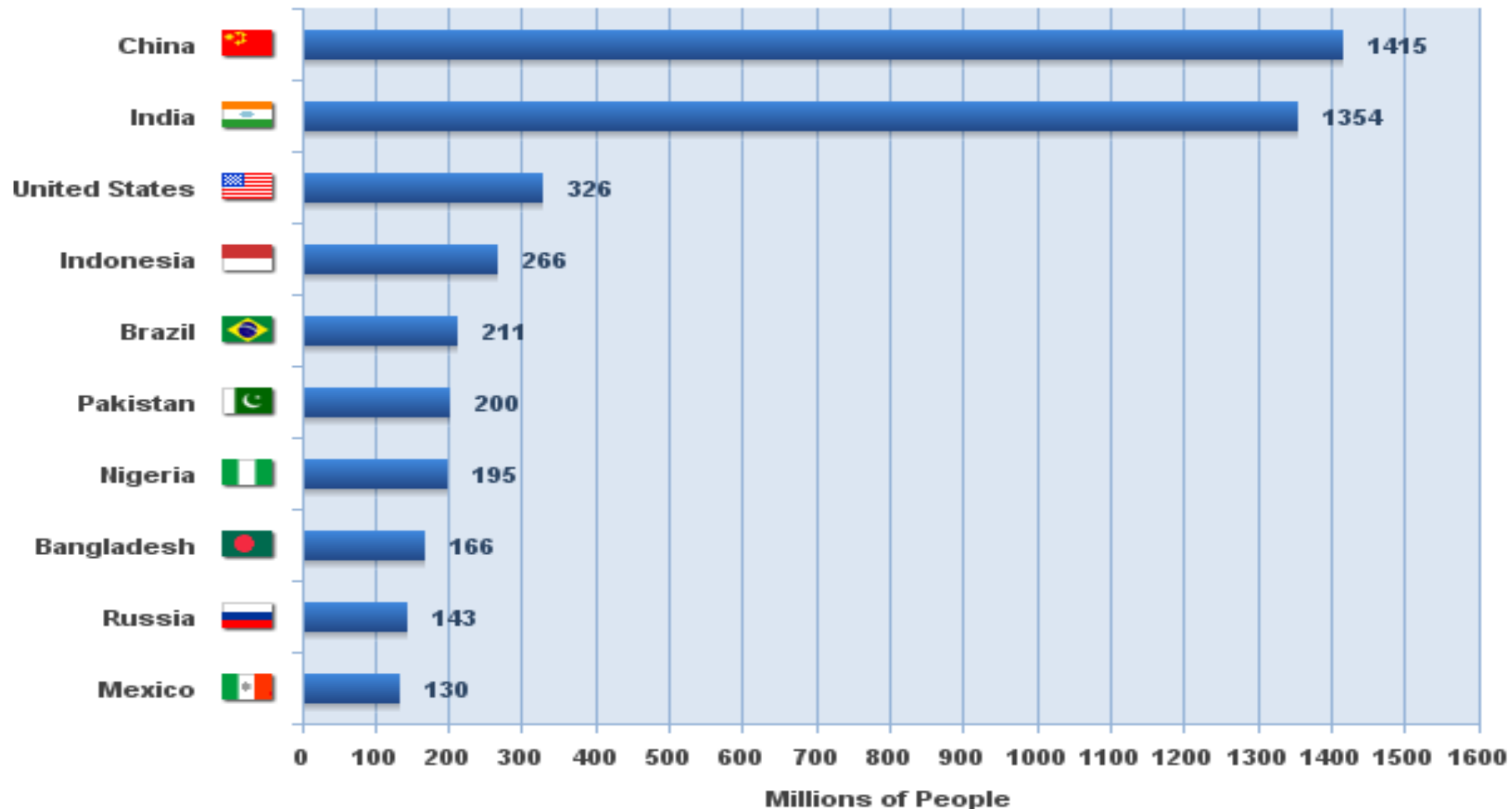

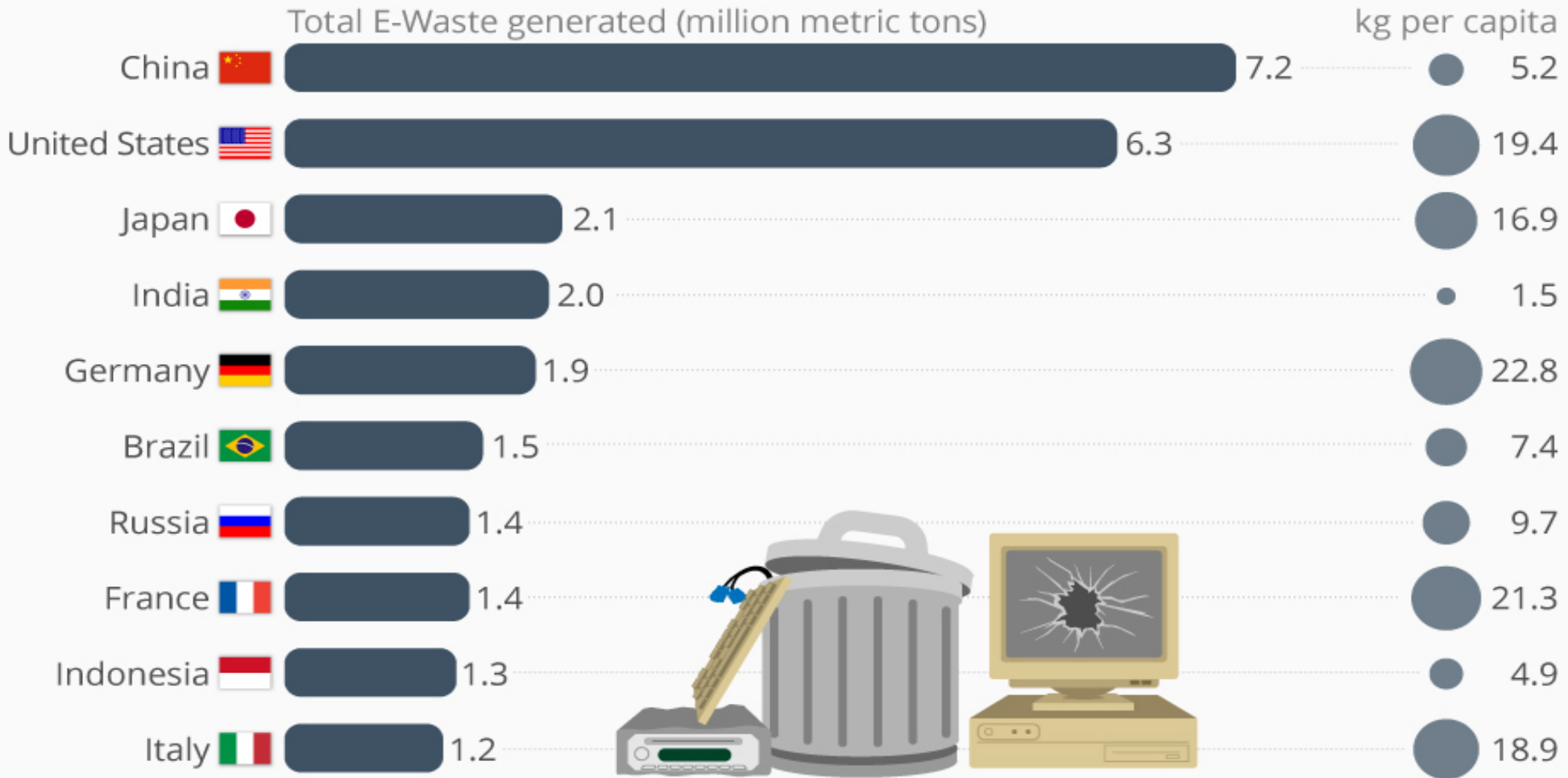
10 Most Populated Countries in the World

Top 10 countries by the amount of e-waste generated in 2016*



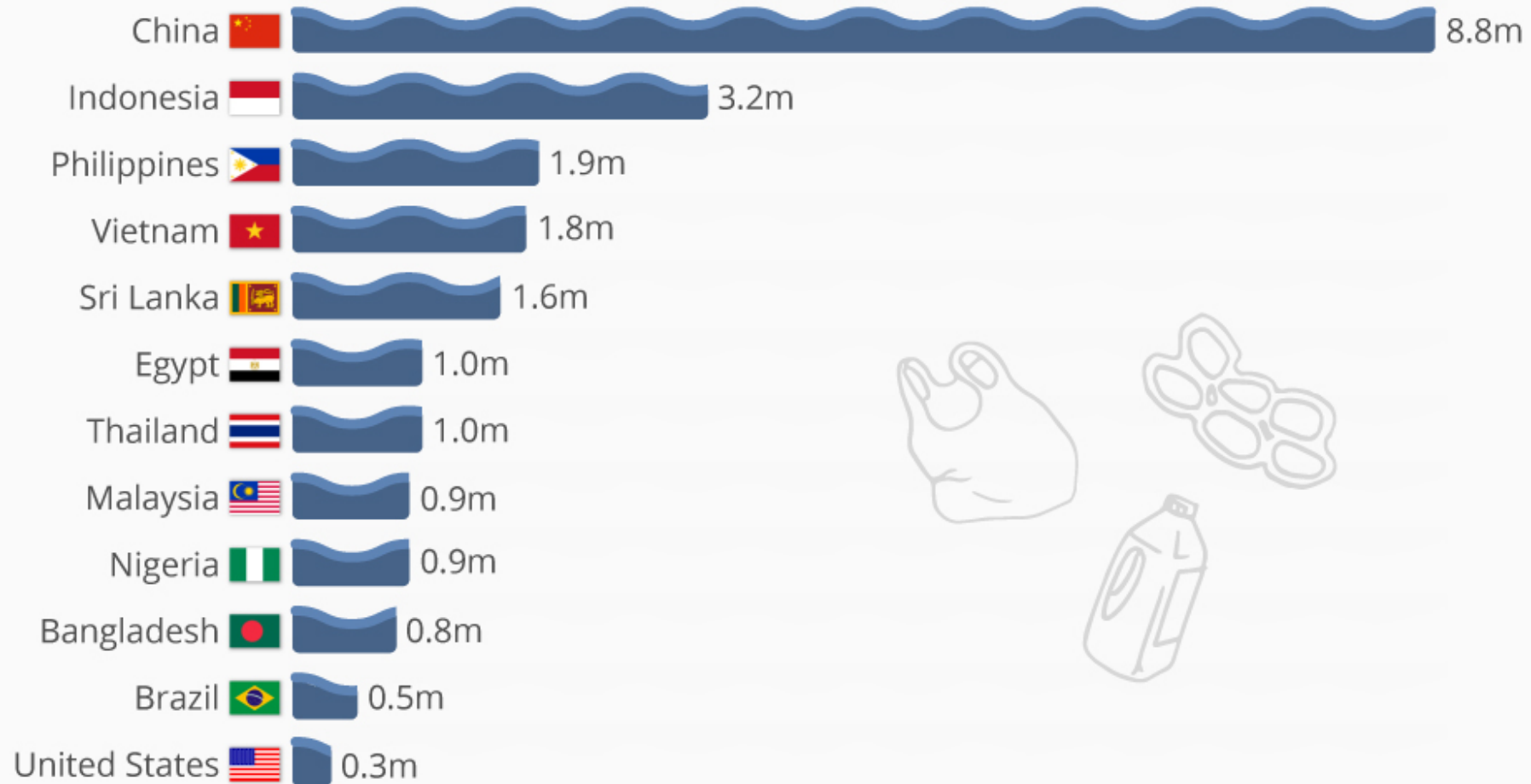

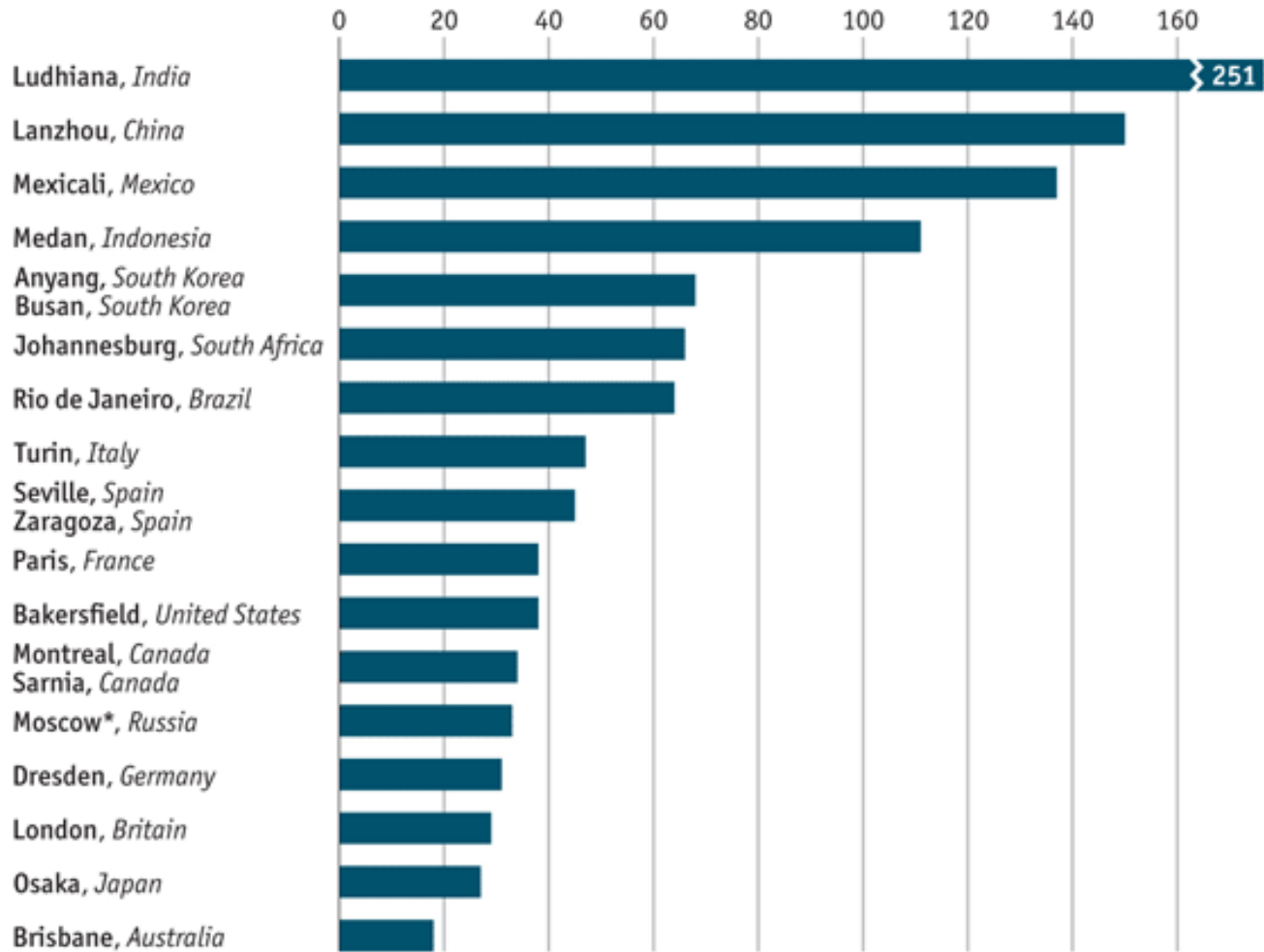

Particulate matter with diameter of 10 microns or less, micrograms per cubic metre

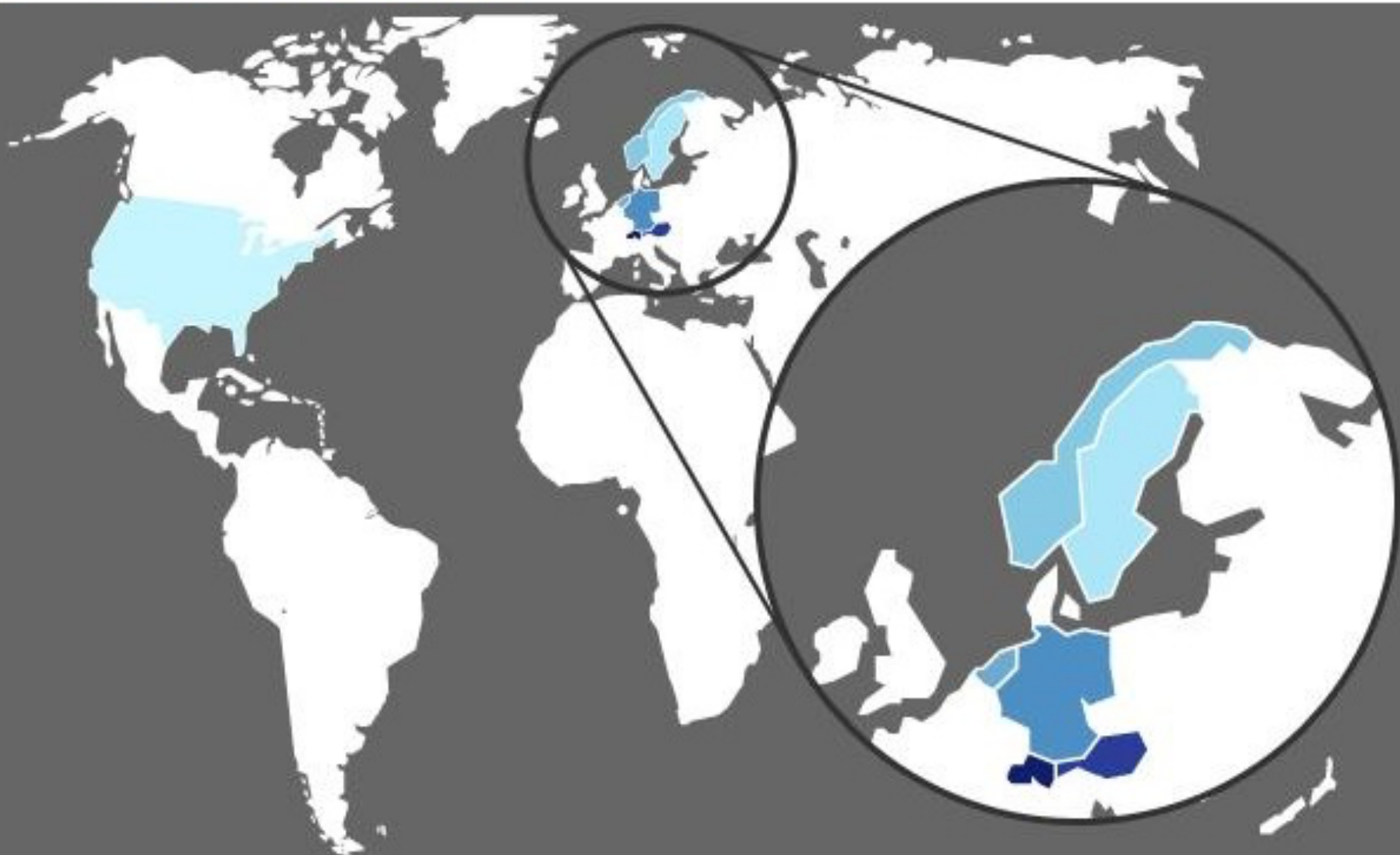

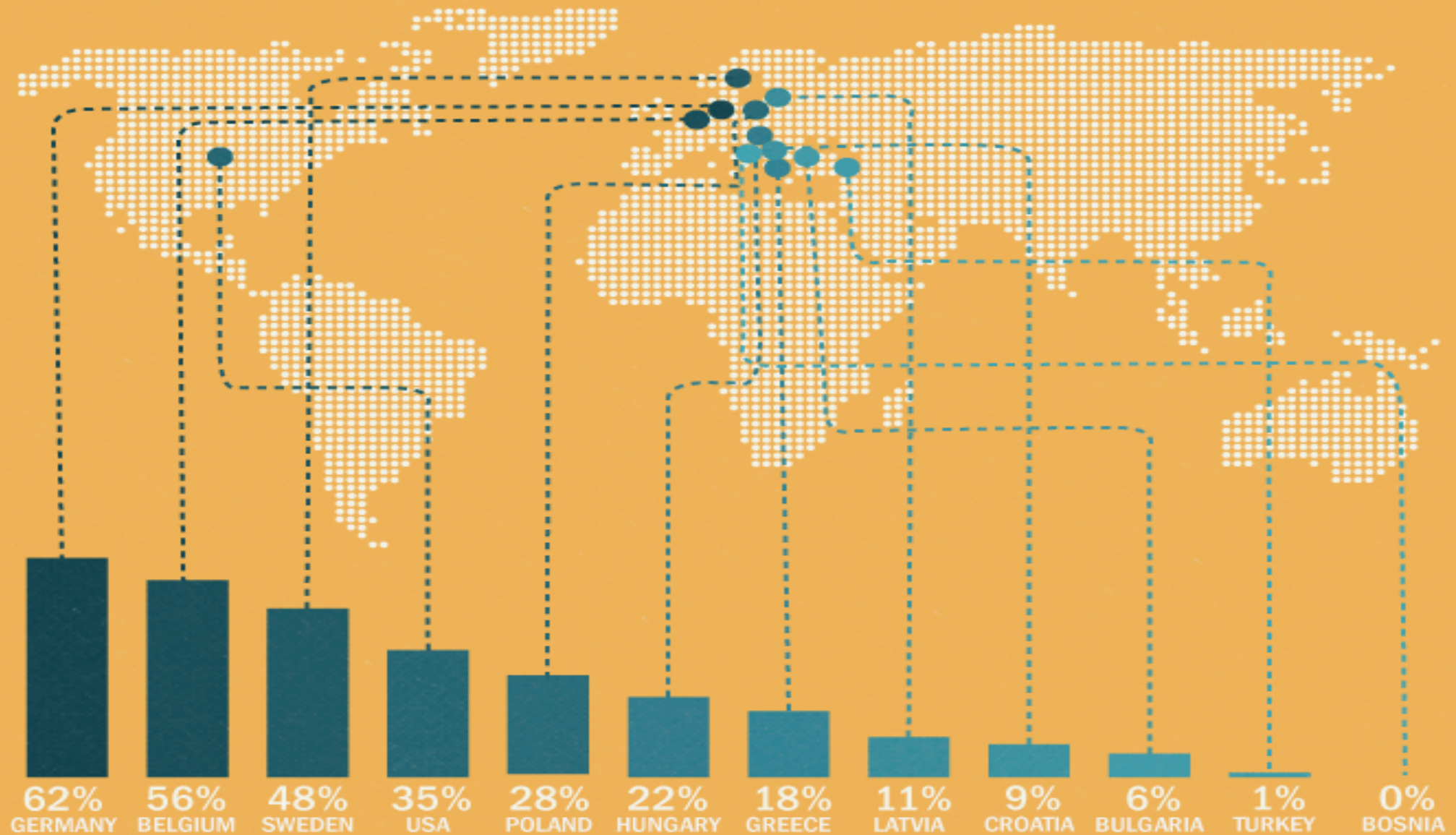
